- 1) Rules: The following rules will be used. These rules will be interpreted by the Tournament Official. Any violation of these rules or State Water Patrol regulations shall be reason for disqualification.
- 2) Eligibility: All individuals must be 18 years of age or older unless participating with a parent or guardian.
- 3) Entry Fee: **\$100** per boat.
- 4) Tournament Hours: 6am - 2pm (Check in – 5:00AM)
- 5) Take off: Will be order of entry received
- 6) Tackle & Equipment: Only artificial lures or baits may be used. All bass must be caught alive on a rod and reel during tournament hours from the boat. No trolling.

- 7) Boats and Motors: 40HP max on outboards motors. If motor exceeds 40hp trolling motors may be used, but outboard must be propped out of the water. Boats must have properly working aerated live-wells and kill switches.
- 8) Safety & Sportsmanship: Safe boating and fishing practices must be practiced at all times. Life jackets must be worn with kill switches attached anytime outboard is running. No alcohol.
- 9) Permitted fishing locations: not within 25 yards of another contestant boat or take off area.
- 10) Scoring: Largemouth Species will be weighed. Only 5 fish per boat may be weighed in. 15 inch size limit. All fish measured on a flat BPS bump board. 2 pound deduction for a short fish weighed, plus the loss of that fish. 1 pound penalty per dead fish. Only live fish may be weighed for big bass. No culling inside take-off cove/weigh-in area. Weighing more than 5 fish results in disqualification. Late penalty will be 1 pound per minute up to 10 minutes. Over 10 minutes results in disqualification.
- 11) Ties: Broken by earliest entry fee
- 12) Tournament meeting: 10 minutes before take-off.
- 13) Tournament Cancellation: If cancelled due to reasons of safety there will be no refunds. All money will be donated to Relay for Life.
- 14) Insurance: Upon request, proof of boat liability insurance must be provide with minimum liability limit of \$300,000.
